



Residency Art Forms: Dance

Creativity and movement form the core of A4LSD dance residencies. Students delve into basic elements of dance, recognizing their bodies as vehicles for expression, and communication through time, space, and energy. Dance residencies encourage motor skill development, concentration, self-expression, confidence, and problem solving as individuals and as members of a group. Students develop or strengthen team work skills through dance composition, choreography, and improvisation.

Things to Consider:

- Space – The teaching artist will need a designated open dance space where the students can move freely without fear of disturbing next door or downstairs neighbors.
- Discrete Arts vs Arts Integration - Classroom teachers may choose to have their students learn the art form from the teaching artist or collaborate with the teaching artist to integrate the art form with another core content area to deepen the learning in both areas.
- Teacher Engagement – This is an experience for teachers and students alike! The level of involvement will depend on the objective of the residency. Classroom teachers have a range of choices from simply supporting their students' learning in the art form to co-facilitating arts integration with the teaching artist.
- Extending Learning – Classroom teachers may leverage their residency by extending student learning in a variety of ways including posting learned art vocabulary in the classroom to connect to other learning through the week or having students express other learning through their new dance skills.

Pricing:
