



## Residency Art Forms: Visual Art

Visual Art residencies introduce students to various media, materials, and styles of visual expression. As students engage in art making, they discover how to express themselves through their art. By studying art, students learn to interpret aesthetic and historical ideas. Students will explore different cultures, artists, and art processes and will engage in group discussion and reflection. Students develop their capacity for decision making and problem solving as they tackle the choices and challenges that naturally arise during the art making process.

### Things to Consider:

- Space: Having a work space equipped with a sink and places for storing works in progress is important for visual art residencies.
- Discrete Arts vs Arts Integration - Classroom teachers may choose to have their students learn the art form from the teaching artist or collaborate with the teaching artist to integrate the art form with another core content area to deepen the learning in both areas.
- Teacher Engagement – This is an experience for teachers and students alike! The level of involvement will depend on the objective of the residency. Classroom teachers have a range of choices from simply supporting their students' learning in the art form to co-facilitating arts integration with the teaching artist.
- Extending Learning – Classroom teachers may leverage their residency by extending student learning in a variety of ways including posting learned art vocabulary in the classroom to connect to other learning through the week or having students express other learning through their new visual art skills.
