



## Residency Art Forms: Theatre

Theatre residencies are dynamic and engaging for students of all learning styles; they can include a diverse range of exploratory activities and skill-building from acting to improvisation. Theatre classes help students improve literacy skills, build group cooperation, grow empathy, take risks, develop presentation and public speaking skills, and expand their powers of observation and imagination. Reflecting on their own experiences, students express ideas and feelings by participating in theatrical warm-ups, games & exercises, reading and interpreting plays, folk-tales and creating their own stories.

### Things to Consider:

- Space: Students engaging in theatre activities will need a large open space in which the entire group can fit and work comfortably.
- Discrete Arts vs Arts Integration - Classroom teachers may choose to have their students learn the art form from the teaching artist or collaborate with the teaching artist to integrate the art form with another core content area to deepen the learning in both areas.
- Teacher Engagement – This is an experience for teachers and students alike! The level of involvement will depend on the objective of the residency. Classroom teachers have a range of choices from simply supporting their students' learning in the art form to co-facilitating arts integration with the teaching artist.
- Extending Learning – Classroom teachers may leverage their residency by extending student learning in a variety of ways including posting learned art vocabulary in the classroom to connect to other learning through the week or having students express other learning through their new theatre skills.
